

Supporting local authorities with quality assurance of Out-of-school Settings

1. Local authority commissions 3-day Good Management course for group of up to 10 schools (ideally each school sends MC member and teacher).
Cost £1,350

Each school receives 12-month subscription to NRCSE resources, templates, good practice to support learning throughout the course

2. Local authority/agency commissions quality assurance follow-up programme for 6-8 supplementary schools.
Cost £1,350

NRCSE arranges a 1-to-1 session with each school to assess management file (policies and procedures) and discuss procedure for quality assurance. 6-8 schools take up.

Quality Mark portfolio preparation workshop, 3hrs weekend or twilight. 5-6 schools attend

3. NRCSE quality development adviser visits school and prepares a Witness Statement confirming what practices they observed, what activities were taking place and reporting on management, teaching and learning observed.
Cost £1,200-£1,440 (£240 per visit and report x 5-6 school visits)

4. Each school logs in to their profile on NRCSE website, enters school details in full, completes self-assessment, submits witness statement and registers for a quality assurance recognition meeting - £130 per school

NRCSE facilitates recognition meetings, local authority officer acts as chair, 1 to 3 school(s) attend plus an independent educational expert (head or deputy head from local primary/secondary school, pro-bono).

5. NRCSE issues Quality Mark certificate and report for each school
Certificate is dated and records specific good practice observed
Local authority arranges celebration of quality
